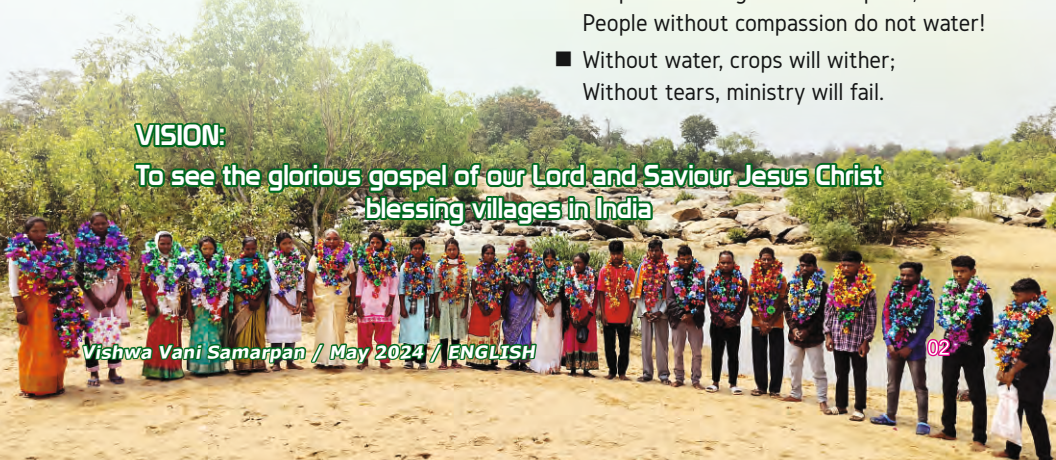

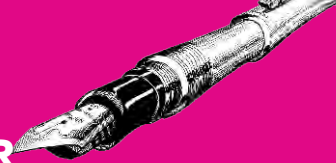

LETTER *from* THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR



Dearly beloved, greetings to you in the name of Lord Jesus Christ who makes the plants grow in its season.

I Praise God, Whenever I Remember You:

According to Phil 1:2-6, I remembered your love for Christ, your efforts, and munificent donations, when I started to write this letter. I am praying that God will bless your family abundantly, that the future of your children, who have written their exams and are stepping into higher classes will be brighter, that the life of the young children be blessed with suitable partners and those who are married be blessed with children. I also pray that they might receive grace from God, as they expect promotions and suitable jobs and family members be blessed with good health, and that the income of the head of the family will be sufficient. Let them proceed with the faith that God leads their family and they shall never be lacking in anything. May the Lord protect your family and all the family members of the servants of God from the heat of the sun and offer His grace to be content in all things.

It is Christ who strengthens:

I praise God for enabling all the promotional workers of each province to meditate on the Word of God focusing on Philippians 4:13, pray and plan for the ministry's financial support during the beginning of this financial year. The action plan for this financial year is sharing the gospel in 7000 villages. Through the prayers and financial supports raised by representative and all the development team, field workers light the torch of the gospel in villages door-to-door. The people who are caught in the clutches of the devil will be delivered. The darkness of ignorance will be removed, and the True Light will shine forth. Great joy and prosperity will overflow. The names of those who repent from sin will be written in the Book of Heaven and will enable them to attain eternal glory and honor.

God is the foundation for Missionary Work:

It is not an exaggeration, if we say that Holy Spirit is the driving force behind The growth and prosperity of missionary work. No man is worthy enough to take up the credit or reputation for it. As I Corinthians 3:5 says, "Only servants, through whom you came to believe as the Lord has assigned to each his task." Following that, Paul, in verses 6 and 7 says, God who makes things grow is important and not the workers. We must never forget that we are co-workers of God.

1. Diversity of Mission

Jesus has said in Matthew 13:1-9 that there are various types of ministry. Apostle Paul talks about five kinds of ministry in his epistle to Ephesus (4:11-13). A farmer tills the ground, another sows the seed. While some other person waters the plant, it is God who makes them grow. When Paul compares the church to the body of a person with various parts, he gives importance to the multifaceted approach. Through Vishwa Vani Ministries, we work at a multifaceted level. But our prime goal is to share the gospel in the unreached villages in India.

2. Unity of Purpose

We must bear in mind that whatever ministry we do, we are a part of the task of harvesting the souls. Apostle Paul, Apollos and Peter never had competition among themselves. Rather, they completed their task under the leadership of Christ. Though there were different facets in ministry, there was unity in purpose and in the Spirit (1 Cor. 3:7-10).

The fulltime workers in the various nine departments of Vishwa Vani, prayer group leaders and the voluntary representatives work together for the same purpose. We proclaim the gospel, with single mindedness of purpose, by working with all understanding with various churches, missions and leaders of independent churches.

3. Humility in Spirit

We need the support of men in the proclamation of the gospel. But, all those who forget and deny that it is God who makes it grow are proud. Men should not take the glory that has to be given to God. Every man gets wages according to his work. God gives wages that are due to a person. It is not important what people think about us; but what is important is whether God can look at us and say, 'Well Done, good and faithful servant.'

"Even now the one who reaps draws a wage and harvests a crop for eternal life, so that the Sower and the reaper may be glad together (Jn 4:36). Hence, 'We are unworthy servants; we have only done our duty.'" (Lk 17:10). We must have the mind and spirit of John, the Baptist to say, "He must become greater; I must become less." (Jn. 3:30) Though we plant and you water, it is Lord Jesus Christ, the Master of the Harvest, who makes it grow!

Support our efforts to actualize our vision:

1.As Voluntary Representative, Prayer Group In-charge:

- (1) We need people who keep praying, reading the Word of God and soul-winning as a part of their Christian life.
- (2) It is necessary to take part in ministry, egged on by God's love,

without looking at race, caste, church, or organization.

- (3) You can voluntarily support the ministry by praying together, visiting the ministry partners in your area on behalf of development staff, collecting savings boxes and monthly offertory, giving them receipts and offering spiritual counseling to the believers .
- (4) We welcome young men and women who could voluntarily support us in the Vision-Action plan.

2. As a Ministry-Partner

- (1) You can be a part of the ministry by receiving an offering box for free, pray daily for ministry and support us through your offertory, once in six months.
- (2) You could support Samarpan Magazine by donating Rs 100 as Annual Subscription.
- (3) You can donate Rs 4000 every month to adopt a village and help in sharing the gospel.
- (4) You can donate liberally for the construction of churches in North India and meet their needs.
- (5) You can unite new believers and their families and encourage them to pray and support the ministry.

3. Full-Time Promotional Worker

- (1) We need youth who have completed their 12th standard, who are under 30 years of age, and who have accepted Jesus as their personal Savior and have the call for full-time ministry and are willing to do God's work faithfully.
- (2) People who have the vision to ring the church bells in villages that have not heard about Jesus even once with the help of native workers, Indian donors and prayer warriors.
- (3) It is necessary that the candidate must be team-oriented, hardworking and has desire to win souls for Christ.
- (4) It is also needed to keep healthy relationships with colleagues, ministry representatives and church elders. Moreover, the worker needs to submit the donations that are collected faithfully to the Head Office.

4. Mission-Vision Oriented Churches:

- (1) Give opportunities to share about mission work during the worship service.
- (2) Encourage youth to take part in the ministry through 'North India Field Visits'.
- (3) Pray for the missionary work with burden and support the ministry monthly.

- (4) Construct a church building on behalf of their church in the mission-field where there are no churches.
- (5) Encourage youth to take part in personal evangelism, and commit themselves as full time-missionaries.

New Ezras have Set Out to Reach the Unreached Villages

45 young missionaries from the training centres in Gujarat and Andhra Pradesh have completed their training through the grace of God and are going to reach 225 new villages. We need churches and families who could adopt their villages by sending Rs 4000/- every month. Please pray to start classes in North India, North-East India and Odisha in the next phase.

Vishwa Vani Vacation Bible School (VVBS):

We are going to conduct Vacation Bible School for 26,504 children who are attending 3277 worship groups. We need Rs 40 lakhs to conduct VBS for providing books, writing materials and food for children, on an average of Rs 150/- per child. Kindly come forward to support this ministry.

Parliamentary Elections:

As believers, getting ready to execute our democratic obligation, our prayers must be that God should provide good national leaders like Joseph. God who listened to the prayers of Mordecai and Esther will answer us too. The gospel of Jesus Christ - **The one who plants is important,** **The one who waters is very important,** **The One who makes it grow is the most important!**

Dearly beloved,

I thank you for your intention to read these words of mine.

As one who rejoices in Lord Jesus Christ, and as one who has imprinted in the heart that the gospel of Lord Jesus Christ should reach people in all directions, and also be accepted, I would like to share a few words on the above title.

People who know that the gospel of Jesus Christ is very important, meaningful and blessing to one's life shall metamorphose into people who will proclaim the gospel!

People who thus proclaim the gospel are categorized into two by the Holy Bible:

- 1) People who plant – they are important!
- 2) People who water – they are very important!

Yes, people who plant are important in the gospel work!

What it is to be important?

People who give importance to important things become Important in the sight of God!

When Paul says, "I planted" (I Cor 3:6), it denotes

His understanding of his role to "plant" in gospel ministry.

God tells how Paul is very important to Him (Acts 9:15,16)

There is an important message in the tongues of important people!

What is the message?

"Man is a sinner, he needs a Savior,

The Savior is Jesus Christ!"

This message is important to all mankind,

Though it may not appear so to the world,

Though many rise up in anger against

the act of calling man a 'sinner'

Though the idea of Jesus being the only savior may irritate,

As long as bad thoughts dominate the mind,

bad words stay on in the mouth, eyes are lecherous,
heart is wicked, behavior is vile, and vices are hidden,
Man cannot call himself 'pure' and 'pristine.'
His conscience will prick him, and all those who have guilty
conscience are criminals, sinners!

The Bible says, all have turned away,
They have together become worthless;
There is no-one who does good, not even one! (Romans 3:12)

The Bible also says,
Jesus Christ came to the earth to redeem sinners!
People who know this secret,

People who plant the "Indestructible Seed" by bending and
humbling themselves

They go to the places that the Holy Spirit instructs,
Knock every door and preach the important message face to face!
They move to forests, mountain ranges, deserts, cities,
villages and islands that the Holy Spirit reveals to them!
They do not care about seasons, weather or about food!
They don't worry whether there are shops, schools for their
children, medical facilities, roads and safe drinking water!

They are never get caught up in the dilemma
whether they will be accepted or rejected!
They run in haste on hearing the voice of the Holy Spirit
"Go, I will send you faraway" (Acts 22:21)!

Yes, they plant, They touch the hearts of the people – hence
They are important!
They are called like Aaron – hence
They are important!
They are the ones who heard the voice of God like Isaiah –
hence they are important!
Beloved, people who go for planting are young!
Except Peter, the other 11 disciples were less than 30 years!

They were illiterates, steeped in ignorance, but
they were important to the God of Gods!

People who water are very important in gospel work!

Then (Exodus 17:8-13)

Joshua stood to plant the Israelites among the Amalekites,
In fact, he stepped into the battlefield to sow the seed for the
coming of the Messiah!

Moses, Aaron and Ur, all the three,
watered for the sake of Joshua, through their tears,
By climbing great heights!

Joshua is an important person,
But these three have become very important!
Why?

When they watered, Joshua was able to win,
When they stepped back, Joshua also retreated!

Paul planted – he is an important person!
Apollo watered – he is a very important person!
The name “Apollo” means the one who destroys or breaks!
But the Holy Spirit made him to water Paul!
It was difficult to comprehend certain matters that Paul said
(II Peter 3:16)

Apollo who had the ability to explain things in an easy way
went wherever Paul went and explained Paul's messages!
Paul says in I Corinthians 3:6 that
Apollo was not a man who made fun of him,
nor was he one who talked ill or accused him
Nor was Apollo building his ministry at the cost of another,
He watered the plants to grow – Hence he is very important!

- The crops planted by Joshua
Were watered by three!
- The crops planted by Paul
Were watered by Apollo and 30 other people!
We see some of them in Romans, Chapter 16!
All were very important people!
Everyone including Phoebe and the couple Aquila and Priscilla
Watered Paul to the extent he needed!

They were of great help!
They risked their lives for Paul! (Romans 16:4)
They are very important people!

In gospel ministry, one who plants is important
One who waters is very important – but
The God who makes it grow is the most important!

He said “Apart from Me, you could do nothing” (John 15:5) –
hence He is the most important person!

Acts 4:12 says
salvation is found through no-one else except “Jesus” –
hence He is the most important person!

We did not make this crippled man walk
“By our own power or godliness”
The name of Jesus has done this- hence
He is the most important person!

He has the authority on the earth to forgive the sins (Luke 5:24) –
hence He is the most important person!

We cannot do anything against the truth (II Corinthians 13:8) –
hence He is the most important person!

The Psalmist says in Psalm 127:1
“Unless the Lord builds the house, its builders labor in vain” –
hence He is the most important person!

The heavens have declared
“I know, O Lord, that a man's life is not his own;
It is not for man to direct his steps” (Jeremiah 10:23) –
hence He is the most important person!

Paul himself said, “It does not therefore depend on
Man's desire or effort, but on God's mercy” (Romans 9:16) –
hence Jesus is the most important person!

The Father, Son and the Holy Spirit
is the most important person!

He said: I hate Esau. Why?

He said: I love Jacob. Why?

- The heart of Jacob desired to come near God
even though he had committed many mistakes!

But it was not so with Esau!
Jacob battled with God
for His blessings,
But Esau battled with
himself!

- The Lord is
faithful to the faithful,
blameless to the blameless,
Poor to the poor
and shrewd to the crooked.

Who are the ones
who plant in the gospel work of
Jesus Christ?

All those who have
written a 'will' that
their hearts belong to Jesus!

Who are those who water?
People who love and feed
those who proclaim the gospel -
Full time workers, pastors,
preachers and independent
workers!

To you, beloved,
Whose hearts are burdened
for the villages of India
and have adopted villages,
If you turn to be important
and very important people
in the gospel work
of Jesus Christ,
Then Jesus Christ will become
the most important person
to you and your family!
Your part will be
filled with riches above riches,
Amen! ●

FROM THE NETWORK CHAIRMAN

Dearly beloved brothers and sisters, avid readers of Samarpan, your constant prayer gives us the strength to turn the vision of Vishwa Vani Ministry into reality.

Grace and peace be unto you from the Father God and Lord Jesus Christ, our Saviour!

I thank the Lord for giving us the opportunity to proclaim that Jesus Christ is the Lord and Saviour from Jammu Kashmir to Kanyakumari and from Gujarat to Manipur (Acts 5:31).

I am here to share the ministries in North India namely in the states of Jammu and Kashmir, Punjab, Himachal Pradesh, and Uttarakhand.

An Overview of States...

The rivers Jhelum, Chenab and Ravi which flow through Jammu and Kashmir flourish the mountains, valleys and plains that stand as northern boundary for the nation. There are 20 districts with 1 crore and 22 lakh people. They speak Kashmiri, Dogri, Hindi and Urdu which are official languages, while Kashmir, Gojri, Pahari, Punjabi, Bhadarwahi, Sarazi, Khowar, Shina, Burushaski, and Bateri are dialects. It is 23,409 feet above sea level. Nun Kun mountain range is situated here.

Himachal Pradesh is one of the 13 states that are over the mountains in India. This is in the western part of the Himalayas. It has 13 jillas and 68 lakh and 64 thousand people reside here. Shimla is the capital with 20,934 villages. People speak Himachali, Hindi and Kinnauri with more than 86.06% education.

Punjab is the 19th state that has the greatest landscape in India. The tributaries of Sindhu namely Sutlej, Beas, and Ravi flow through it. Among the 2 crores and 77 lakh people in Punjab 37.48% are in cities and 62.52% are in villages. There are 13,087 villages in Punjab.

Uttarakhand means Northern Land. It has two provinces, namely Garhwal and Kumaon. It has 17 districts with 17,033 villages. There are more than 1 crore people. 86% of the state are mountains and 65% are forests. They stand out in the culture, food habits, climatic condition, language and the way that they celebrate festivals. It stands second in financial growth.

Ministry an Overview...

The Lord is mightily using 320 native full-time missionaries in these 4 states.

Vishwa Vani Ministries are going on in these 4 states. According to our vision, we need 1600 full-time workers who will share the gospel in 8000 villages. At present, there are 320 missionaries.

Our coordinating office for ministry in these 4 states is in Pathankot which touches three states. We need a training center here for the ministry. Hence, we need to purchase one acre of land and construct a training center that is 5000 sq ft. By the grace of God, we have 8 training centers in the field namely Atchapuvalasa (A.P), Tarangada (Odisha), Navapada (Gujarat), Laghadwal (Maharashtra), Nawatoli (Jharkhand), Sureri (Uttar Pradesh), Siliguri (West Bengal) and Vishwa Vani Kami (Tripura). The ministry in these centers is also flourishing. These centers also accommodate our ministry partners, when they visit the mission fields.



The ministry from these four states is supported by the believers from South Tamil Nadu. We need to complete the construction of the Pathankot training center in this financial year. We need Rs.50 lakhs to purchase the land and do the related things. We also require Rs.1 crore to construct the 5000 sq. ft training center. In sum, we need Rs.1 crore and 50 lakhs.

We are taking efforts to raise funds for the purchase of land through the believers in North India and for the construction of the building from the believers in South India. We believe that the Lord will certainly make it through. This training center will be helpful to train the new workers and elders from North India, accommodate the ministry partners from other parts of India who visit the fields of this region and conduct Prayer Camps. We request your involvement in the purchase and construction of the training center.

WHICH IS IMPORTANT?

STARTING IT?

CONTINUING IT?

FINISHING IT?

This is not a debate where three parties pour out their opinions. We are not to explain sowing, growing or harvesting. What is gospel work? How should we approach it? What is our role in it? This article is to find answers for these questions.

Apostle Paul in I Corinthians 3 explains his role in gospel work and what people who continue the work must do. The reasons were jealousy, altercations, and disagreements found in the church at Corinth, those days. How does Apostle Paul handle these problems found in the church and what kind of solutions does he offer to overcome these problems? Even today, churches are plagued by jealousy, and vitiating arguments, resulting in division in the churches and splinter groups. It is better to focus on what Paul gives as a solution.

Keep in mind, the words of Paul in I Cor. 1:13, "Is Christ divided?" This message is not for people who are outside the church. Instead, it is given as a warning to the believers who are part of the church, the body of Christ and the workers in God's Ministry.

It is our duty to proclaim the gospel. We have nothing to boast about proclaiming the gospel. There is no pride in accomplishing God's

ministry. No one is better than the other in this. That is why Paul warns the church at Corinth to remove the spirit of division amongst them. Consider I Cor. 3:5. "What, after all, is Apollos? And what is Paul? Only servants, through whom you came to believe—as the Lord has assigned to each his task.

What is Planting?

We often remember the song based on Genesis 8:22 "Seedtime and Harvest will never cease on earth." We either sow or plant. Proclaiming the gospel to the people who have not known that Jesus came to earth to forgive our sins and there is eternal life for those who believe and accept them is just a beginning. Do we need this beginning? Is it over and above the other two ministries? There is no point in debating over it. Romans 10:14 says "How, then, can they call on the one they have not believed in? And how can they believe in the one of whom they have not heard? And how can they hear without someone preaching to them?" Hence it is very important to share the gospel.

Today, the gospel is preached in the same place over and over again. If the message of salvation is proclaimed again to those who have accepted Jesus as their Savior, when will others who have not heard the gospel listen to it? When will they get an opportunity to believe in Jesus and confess? Emil Annan has sung beautifully, "If those who knew the Gospel had not preached, How will those who have not heard it believe?" Today we must decide that we are ready to proclaim the gospel for a bountiful harvest.

Let us ponder over to what extent we have been involved in proclaiming the gospel to the unreached people like Paul (2 Cor 10:16) Are we sowing at the right place? We must be careful in choosing the place where we are going to sow the Word, whether it is a good ground or a stony place? Hence prayer is the prime tool in this work of sowing the seed. We must continue to pray for the soul and the villages that we ought to share the gospel. The Holy Spirit must open the hearts of the people as He did for Lydia. Only then, the ministry of sowing will be complete. Apostle Paul sowed the Word of God in unreached and unknown places.

What is Watering?

Sowing here and there, not being aware of where and to whom we are sowing is not proper ministry and being content that we have accomplished God's work, is not proper ministry nor is it proper sowing. As a result, we are unable to do the follow-up ministry in the the sowing ministry.

Consider the work of the missionary in Vishwa Vani Ministries who is in charge of five villages. He visits the five villages once every week on a particular day and maintains contact with them.

This is the first phase of work. He gathers those whom he has contacted and those who are interested and conducts Seekers' Meeting and invites them to attend the weekly Bible Study Group. The people who are attending the Bible Study Groups do get the opportunity to learn the Word of God. This is the Watering Ministry. It is important that the souls that have heard the gospel once must be followed up.

It was Apollos who watered. The people who attend the Bible Study Group regularly open their hearts for Jesus and they are led to have the assurance of forgiveness of their sins. Following that, the new believer professes his faith in Christ. After the faith confession service, he now becomes a believer who worships the Lord and eventually becomes a member of the church. This is the methodology that is followed in our mission fields.

Why can't we follow this pattern in our fields? We could share the Word of God continuously with friends who do not know Jesus, to lead them towards faith and make them confess the faith. If we utilize this opportunity, we are wise. Apollos, watered all the places where Paul had sown the seed and performed the follow-up ministry.

Causing Growth - What does it mean?

Acts 2:47 says, "And the Lord added to their number daily those who were being saved." Jesus said in Matthew 16:16-18 that He will build His church over this stone. The Holy Spirit makes those whose sins are forgiven and those who believe in the Name become members of the church. Then, He makes them the child of God. The harvesting of souls is causing growth.

The first phase in the work of the Holy Spirit is to instruct us about sin, righteousness, and judgement (Jn 16:8-11). The second phase that causes growth is, all those who are pierced by Jesus in their hearts accepting Him (Acts 2:37,38). The third phase is that those believers gather together, worship the Lord, partake in the breaking of the bread and have fellowship (Acts 13:1-3). The fourth phase is, people who worship commit themselves to proclaim the gospel, take up the responsibility to send missionaries.

same. May the increase in the number of souls- churches in the fields in India add greater praise, glory, honor and esteem to the Master of the Harvest!



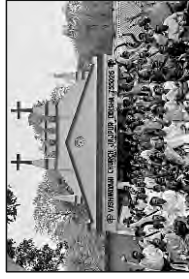

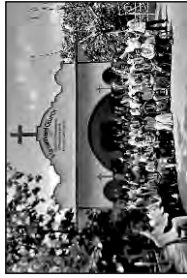

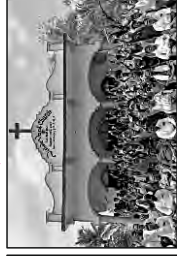
